

WATER METER TESTING

Revised Water Fitting Standards and Requirements — Do You Meet Them?

In Singapore, all private water meters are regulated by the Public Utilities Board (PUB).

Recently, PUB has rolled out a set of new prerequisites and regulations which will take effect from 1 June 2023. Such changes include the mandated compliance with the standards ISO 4064: 2014 and OIML R49: 2006. The meters shall be tested by an SAC-accredited test laboratory or its Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) partners

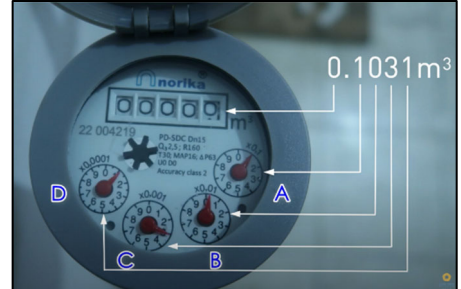


All private water meters must adhere to these requirements before they are allowed to be offered for sale, displayed, or advertised for water service installations in Singapore.
